### CHES<sup>®</sup> Eligibility

#### An eligible individual has:

- A Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctoral Degree from an accredited institution, AND
- A major in: health education, community health education, public health education, school health education, OR
- 25 semester hours (37 quarter hours) specific to course work related to areas of responsibility and competencies



- 5 years experience as a health education specialist

- 2 letters of recommendation

- Competency-based pencil- andpaper (PBT) exam
- 165 multiple-response questions
- Identifies each Area of Responsibility
- Offered at over 130 testing locations nationwide







### Continuing Competency



#### NCHEC's Definition of Continuing Competency:

Demonstrating specified levels of knowledge, skills, or ability not only at the time of initial certification but throughout an individual's professional career. The NCHEC recertification requirements demonstrate continued competence.
